#E Consider Approval of 2016 Encumbered Funds - Discussion Ensnues - Susan A m/m to approve encumbered funds as presented, Kevin R 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried. (See attached encumbrances)

#F Consider Approval of a New Employment Contract for Town Manager Dax Norton – Eric M m/m to approve contract as presented and authorize Town Council President to sign the contract, Susan A 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.

#G Consider Approval of Low Bid for the Whitestown Parkway Median Project – Discussion ensues – Original estimate was \$365,000. Dax spoke on winning bid from Calument. Dawn S brought up issues with the punctuality of Calument on former projects. Dax explained that weather was an issue with former projects. Late fees can be added to the contract. Kevin R brought up concerns with traffic on the Parkway during construction as was with Perry Worth Rd. GRW will be supervising this project. DPW employee will be inspecting this project. Dawn S m/m to accept the bid for Calument with stipulations, NTE \$297,738.00, Susan A 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.

#H Consider Approval of Annual Contract with GRW – Dax spoke and reviewed contract. Dan Cutshaw, GRW spoke regarding contract. Rates have not increased from last year. Dawn S m/m to accept contract as presented, Susan A 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.

#I Consider Approval of a Revised Town Calendar of Meetings (Council Meetings To Be Held on the 2nd Wednesday of Each Month at 7 p.m.) – Eric M m/m to approve as presented, Kevin R 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.

#J Recognition of Outgoing Town Council Member (Dawn Semmler) – Presentation of Proclamation

#K Consider Appointments to Boards and Commissions – Eric M m/m to appoint Susan Austin as council representative to the Parks Board and appoint Matt Sumner as replacement of Katie Klimaszewski on the Parks Board, Kevin R 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.

#L Discuss Citizens Rate Increase Request – Dax Norton spoke regarding the potential rate increase. Steve Unger spoke on this subject. Two items to consider, the rate itself and how Citizens bills us. Citizens proposed a 34% increase the settlement was actually at 17%. We do not know exactly how that will impact our customers. Reedy Financial will do a study to determine the impact on customers. We will need to do a rate study. There will be a hearing before the IURC in early January. Steve is asking for permission to sign off on the settlement on behalf of Whitestown. Kevin R asked about digging our own wells. It was explained that this has been investigated and is cost prohibitive. Discussion ensues. Susan A spoke and thanked Steve Unger for his work on this project. Susan A m/m to authorize Bose McKinney to accept the settlement offer and to approve Rate Increase Study, Dawn S 2nd, vote 4-0, motion carried.
