RESOLUTION NO. 2016- 1**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING AN INCREASE OF LOCAL INCOME TAX RATES TO  
PROVIDE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY**

WHEREAS, the Boone County Income Tax Council ("ITC") is empowered to, among other things, establish and increase local income tax rates for Boone County, Indiana;

WHEREAS, the Whitestown Town Council ("Town Council"), as the fiscal body of the Town of Whitestown, Indiana ("Town"), is a voting member of the ITC;

WHEREAS, other members of the ITC are considering an increase of the local income tax rate by 0.5% - from 1.0% to 1.5% - with the additional 0.5% allocated to public safety purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Whitestown Board of Metropolitan Police Commissioners has considered the proposed increase and believes it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town and of Boone County, as it will increase funding to public safety departments in the Town, including the Whitestown Metropolitan Police Department, and throughout Boone County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Whitestown Board of Metropolitan Police Commissioners as follows:

**Section 1.** The Whitestown Board of Metropolitan Police Commissioners urges the Town Council to support and take all steps necessary to approve and implement the 0.5% increase of the Boone County local income tax rate.

**Section 2.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
