



## Public Works/Utility May 2015 Council Report

### WASTEWATER

- WWTP Construction is at 65% completion and is still set to open 9/1/15.
- Construction of the WWTP five-bay maintenance barn has commenced.
- The IURC has accepted Whitestown's annual Utility Resource Report.

### WATER

- The annual Whitestown Water Quality Report (CCR) has been prepared and will be mailed to residents prior to June 1.
- Routine system maintenance is ongoing.

### STREET DEPARTMENT

- The re-striping of Whitestown Parkway/CR 700 E has been completed and will improve safety at the intersection.
- Perry Worth Rd. paving is scheduled to be completed by the end of this month.
- DPW will be getting quotes this month for resurfacing 2.5 miles of Main St. and resurfacing 1 mile of CR 575 E from CR 300 S to CR 450 S. DPW is also obtaining quotes for a salt storage barn to be constructed this summer.
- DPW staff has begun replacing failing sections of sidewalk in Eagles Nest and then will move to Walker Farms to do the same. The sections being repaired must meet the guidelines set forth in the Whitestown Sidewalk Replacement Policy adopted in 2012.
